BloomBoard will facilitate this program between **October 26 and December 15, 2017** to introduce the platform and lead participants to successful completion.

This **competency-based** professional learning experience will be **self-paced** and completed **on-line**, including **submission of evidence** of learning and application to practice to earn the micro-credential.

Evidence will be reviewed and the micro-credential will be awarded to successful participants through the issuer (not D131).
